MUST KNOW BEFORE YOUR TRAVEL TO LONDON & SCOTLAND

LONDON

Mind the traffic: London has a lot of traffic, especially during rush hours. If you're taking a taxi or using ride-sharing services, factor in potential delays and plan accordingly.

Be prepared for the weather: London's weather can be unpredictable, so be prepared for rain or sudden changes. Pack a lightweight waterproof jacket or carry an umbrella to stay dry.
